ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (a) Date of Birth Block. Candidate born between 27 June 2002 and 27 December 2005 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be
- 6 Manital Status. Only unmarried Indian male and female candidates are eligible for enrolment as Agniveerveyu in IAF. Candidates will have to give a cortificate of being "unmarried" at the time of errolment. Agniveerveyu will not be permitted to marry during their entire tenure of bur years in the IAF. A candidate may be dismissed from service if he I she marries during his I her tenure or is found to be already married inspite of giving certificate of

Educational Qualification

(a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English tom an Education Board listed as COBSE member with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from a Covernment recognized Polyfechnic institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in diploma course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation, If English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

Passed Two years Vocational course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from State Education Boo Councils which are listed in COBSE with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in vocational course (or in Intermed Mathiculation, if English is not a subject in vocational course).

Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any subjects approved by Central / State Education Boards listed as COBSE member with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed two years' vocational course from Education Boards listed as COBSE member with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in vocational course or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course.

- Mandatory Medical Standards. General Medical Standards for AGNIVEERVAYU are as follows:
 - (a) Height: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms (For Male candidates) and 152 cms (For Female candidates)
 - (b) Weight: Proportionate to height and age.
 - For male candidate's minimum chest circumference will be 77 cms and the chest expansion should be at least 5 cms. For male candidates the chest wall should be well proportioned with minimum range of expans
 - Comeal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable
 - Hearing: Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separately
 - (f) Dental: Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points.

Note: Candidates should bring latest prescription and spectacle for corrected vision, if used. The prescription must bear the signal stamp and registration number of eye specialist. Prescription should not be more than one month old.

- General Health: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He / She should be tree from any active it, acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or communicable disease, infection and skin aliments. Candidate shall be physically at lab/FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.
- (j) Gynaecological Examination (For female candidates): The examination covers external genitalia, hemia orifices and the perinany evidence of stress urinary incontinence or genital prolapse outside introllus.
- Gender (For female candidates): Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on al physical examination, will be rejected as Unfit. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared Unfit.

- 10. <u>Body Tattoo.</u> Permanent body tattoos are not permitted, however, tattoos only on inner face of the fore arms (inside of ebow to the surist), back (dorsal) part of the hand/everse side of the paim and Tribals with tattoo which are as per the custom and radions of their tribes may be considered. However, right to consider a lattoo acceptable or unacceptable will rest with the selection center. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- AGNIVEERVAYU will be enrolled in the indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agniveervayu would form a
 distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agniveervayu beyond the
 analyses of the process engagement period of four year
- 13. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, Agniteerways will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cader of the Indian Air Force as Airmen. These applications will be considered in a centralisation manner based on objective criteria, including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% each specific batch of Agniteeracys will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agnitiveeracys will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Government of India.
- 14. Employability Agniveervayu enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.
- Iraining. On being enrolled, Agniveervayu will be imparted military training based on Indian Air Force requirements.
- Leave. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agniveervayu during their
 - (a) Annual Leave. 30 days per year.
 - (b) Sick Leave. Based on medical advice.
- Medical and CSD Facilities. For the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Air Force, Agniveervayu will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.

- 23. Online Test. Eligible candidates will be sent provisional admit cards for Phase I of testing on their registered e-mail IDs between 48-72 livs prior to the examination. Candidates are required to download the admit card, take a colour printiput and carry the same to the examination center. Name of city & exam date will be intrinated to candidates as an earlier date to enable them plan their movement. This provisional admit card can also be downloaded by the candidate under candidates login on CASB web portal https://grappathyqu.cdsc.in. All candidates in possession of provisional admit card will undertake Online Test at centres designated / alcited as per their admit card. Online test will be objective they and questions will be bilingual (English & Hind) except for English apper. Candidates are to bring one blue / black pen and original AADHAAR card along with them for Phase I testing. Detals of the test are as follows:
 - (a) Science Subjects. Total duration of the online test shall be 60 minutes and shall comprise of English, Physics and Mathematic
 - (b) Other than Science Subjects. Total duration of the online test shall be 45 minutes and shall comprise of English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).
 - (c) <u>Science Subjects & Other than Science Subjects</u>. Total duration of the online test shall be <u>85 minutes</u> and shall comprise of English, Physics and Mathematics as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).

Marks scored by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Testing will be "Normalised" by using the formula as published on the web site https://manipathymu.cdac.in, to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to note that the application of Cut-Off for shortisting candidates for STAR Phase-II testing and preparation of Final Merit List for selection will be based on "hormalised Marks" and "Not on the "Actual Marks" scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I testing, Further, on normalisation, marks scored by a candidate in STAR Phase-I testing, Further, on normalisation, marks scored by a candidate in a subject may become less/more than actual marks, and more than total marks of that subject in exceptional cases.

- 30 Candidates shall sign a consent form prior to appearing in physical fitness test/medical test for selection in IAF. He / She shall appear these tests at his / her own risk and shall not be paid any compensation by IAF for injury/casualty if any, austained by him / her during such test. The consent form shall be signed by parents/guardian of candidates below 18 years of age. The consent form is appended with Phase-II advantage.
- 31. <u>Adaptability Test-1</u>. All candidates who pass the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-1 (objective written test) which is to assess suitability of a candidate for employment in the IAF which involves deployment in varied geographic terms and operational conditions.
- 32. <u>Adaptability Test-II</u>. All candidates who pass Adaptability Test-I shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-II as per policy in vogue Adaptability Test-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by deposting Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury/RBISSI through Electronic Milliary Receivable Order (e.MRO)/Matary Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e.MROM/RO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three working days of medical examination.

- 34. The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces, standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the appeal

- Candidate should enter AADHAAR number in on-line application. Candidates from J&K, Assam and Meghataya are exempted for the same,
 if not having AADHAAR card.
- 40. Candidates are to reach at the examination Centre with colour print out of provisional admit card. Candidates shall be debarred appearing in the online test in case anomalies / irregularities/ incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination or at any subsequent stage of selection process.
